Summary

- PAT rose 57% y-o-y) beating estimates, while revenues grew 23% to Rs 1,192 crore above our expectation of Rs 1,019 crore. OPM rose by 193 bps led by good gross margins.
- Order book recovered by 37% y-o-y to Rs 2000 crore.
- Various expansion plans were achieved and subsidiary performances remain robust; strong balance sheet and dominant domestic position in steel tubes & pipes makes company well-placed to capture medium to long-term growth opportunities
- Subsidiaries and JVs hold key to growth; we maintain a Buy with a revised PT of Rs 2,900 factoring a revenue/profit CAGR of 9/16% over FY25-28. The stock trades at 21x FY28EPS.

Revenues grew 23% y-o-y on a strong show by subsidiaries, while standalone business grew just 5% on lower input prices and margin pressure on certain products. Subsidiary Ravi Technoforge had a strong revenue growth of 40% and Ratnamani Finow Spooling Solutions (RFSS) continues to gain traction with revenue of Rs 110 Crores and strong order visibility, reaffirming its Rs a Rs. 300-crore annual revenue guidance. Several key milestones were achieved in the quarter, including commissioning of Phase I of the Odisha Plant, with Phase II (Coating Plant) expected in Q3. The company also pioneered the supply of hydrogen-compliant carbon steel welded pipes in India, and the Kutch Plant received both the API monogram certification from the American Petroleum Institute and the CII National Award for Excellence in Energy Management 2025. higher realisations and favorable product mix. Baring business in RTL is expected to ramp up margins due to automation and higher demand. The spooling business is also expected to ramp-up execution significantly in FY26. The currently order book stands at Rs 2,000 crore up 37% y-o-y. OPM of 17.7% (up 193 bps y-o-y) was beating our estimates. Consequently, operating profit/PAT is Rs. 211 crore/Rs. 156 crore, up 38%/57% y-o-y.

- Subsidiaries performed strongly; Incremental spending on subsidiaries and JVs to drive growth
- OPM rose 193 bps led by higher gross margins

Standalone sales stayed moderate

Considering the initiatives, We maintain our buy rating for a revised price target of Rs 2,900 factoring in the Revenue/profit CAGR of 9/16% over FY25-28. The stock trades at 21x FY28EPS.

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Outlook and Valuation

■ Sector Outlook - Long-term growth drivers remain intact

The global steel pipes & tubes market is expected to reach \$279 billion by 2027, with a 7.9% CAGR from 2019 to 2027. The Asia-Pacific region has the largest share of the global pipes market and is expected to clock a CAGR of 8.4% in the next four years. India is the third-largest manufacturer of steel pipes, with an estimated market size of Rs. 33,000 crores, which registered a steady 8.2% CAGR over the past 10 years. Although COVID-19 affected the progress of some infrastructure projects, we believe the return of normalcy in economic activities, the government's focus on increasing the participation of local firms in government projects by disallowing global tenders for up to Rs. 200 crore, government spending on infrastructure projects (Jal se Nal, expansion of the National Gas Grid and CGD pipelines, etc), and anti-dumping duties on imports of seamless CS pipes from China would drive overall demand for steel pipes going ahead.

Company Outlook - Well-poised for growth

RMTL is the most prominent manufacturer of nickel alloy/stainless steel seamless and welded tubes/pipes and titanium welded tubes in India and is one of the leading manufacturers of carbon steel (CS) welded pipes. We believe that solid revenue growth would continue over FY2024E-FY2026E, led by a strong order book, higher order inflows, an anticipated increase in government's due to expanded capacities, and an anticipated increase in government spending on infrastructure schemes. RMTL's stainless steel pipes segment will strengthen its leadership position, led by products that would substitute for its expanded capacity and robust demand from refineries and power plants. The management has guided for standalone revenues of Rs. 4500-5000 crore for FY24 and EBITDA margin of 16-18%.

The company has two manufacturing plants located in Gujarat. It manufactures various withs and CS products and value-added products in each segment, having a capacity of 50,000 mtpa and 3,50,000 mtpa. RMTL caters to clients in refineries, petrochemicals, oil and gas, thermal power, nuclear power energy, fertilisers, water distribution, chemicals, and aerospace.

Investment theme

RMTL is expected to sustain a growth momentum path over FY2024E-FY2025E, given the robust demand outlook coupled with the expectation of healthy order intake. The company is expanding capacities in a calibrated manner through a mix of internal accruals and debt. RMTL is a net debt-free company with a stable margin profile and healthy return ratios.

Key Risks

- Softness in demand offtake or delay in commissioning of plant might impact revenue growth momentum.
- Inability to take adequate and timely price hikes to mitigate adverse volatility in input cost material might impact margin profile.
